1. Examination will be conducted in Writing and Viva Voce.

2. Details of Examinations, marks and duration are as follows:

Description of Language Items

1. Reading Comprehension

- a. **Unseen passage:** An unseen passage will be provided, followed by ten questions, each carrying 1 mark.

- b. **Picture reading:**Picture sequence will be given, and they will be asked to create a story based on the pictures.

2. Writing

- a. **Letter writing (formal):**It will include job application/letter of complaint/request/ invitation/other official matters.
Message writing: A situation will be provided by which they will have to compose WhatsApp message and send it to someone.
- b. **Notice writing:** A situation will be provided by which they will have to compose a notice for the school bulletin board.

3. Vocabulary and Usage:

- a. **Synonyms:** They will be asked to write words that have similar meanings.Out of eight options, they will choose 5 words.
- b. **Antonyms:** They will be asked to write words that have opposite meanings.Out of eight options, they will choose 5 words.
- c. **Word collocation:** Correct and incorrect sentences will be given, and they will be asked to choose the correct ones.
- d. **Usage:** Incomplete sentences will be given, and they will be required to complete the blanks with appropriate conjunctions (linkers). Eight options will be provided, from which they must choose five.
- e. **Sentence construction:**They will be asked to create/compose sentences using the given words. Out of eight options, they will choose 5 words.
- f. **Word sequencing:**
 - Jumbled letters:** Scrambled letters of words will be provided, and they will be asked to form correct words.
 - Jumbled words:** Mixed-up words within a sentence or phrase will be provided, and they will be asked to rearrange them into logical or proper sentences.
 - Jumbled sentences:** A set of sentences or phrases will be presented in a disordered sequence, and they will be asked to arrange them in a coherent and grammatically correct order.

- 4. **Translation:** English words or sentences will be provided, and they will be asked to translate them into Mizo language.

5. General Knowledge: Knowledge about Mizoram

- 6. **Viva voce:** Twentyquestions will be asked orally, and they will be required to respond verbally.
